

- 1) **5 Littledale Mews** **Sunday only. Please park on Kellet Lane.**  
A 23 year old garden on a 1/3 acre plot, divided into island beds containing herbaceous perennials & grasses with areas of long meadow grass for contrast.
- 2) **4 The Gardens**  
Mixed garden with small raised bed area for salads and strawberries. Water feature and seating areas.
- 3) **Allotment** **Saturday only.**  
Has narrow sloping path.
- 4) **2 Meadowfield Close** **Sunday only. Toilet.**  
A small artist's garden.
- 5) **41 Clougha Avenue** **♿ access to front only.**  
Mixed garden with fruit trees, fruit cage with soft fruit, vegetable patch, flowers, patio and small lawn.
- 6) **50 Schoolhouse Lane** **No ♿ access.**  
A south facing slope with trees and mixed borders including topiary & roses.
- 7) **69 Lythefell Avenue**  
Interesting garden on different levels, patio with pots, lawn area with shrub/flower borders and vegetable patch. Seating and shelter available.
- 8) **Thornfield (behind 72 High Rd)** **Toilet (small lintel). Short term ♿ Parking.**  
Recently refurbished garden with small pond and view to the South.
- 9) **2 Oak Drive** **Partial ♿ access.**  
Terraced medium sized garden on fairly steep slope, steps and ponds. Great views.
- 10) **5 Beech Road**  
Established garden with a cottage border, vegetable patch and soft fruit area. Open views towards Clougha.
- 11) **Forgewood Cottage** **Sunday only. Refreshments.**  
**Off street parking for 5 cars.**  
Interesting flower arranger's garden with stumpery.
